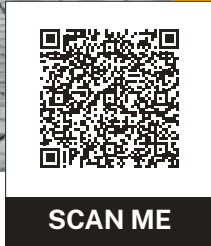


Together, say 'no way' to taking risks around mobile plant, fixed machinery and vehicles



Keep people and plant separated

Separate people from mobile plant and vehicles using barriers, guardrails and exclusion zones.

Move loads that are stable and secured using a certified attachment if needed.

Ensure operators wear a seatbelt if available.

Consult with your workers about how to work safely around moving plant and implementing a traffic management plan.

Preventing access to moving parts of machinery

Always keep the guard on.

Inspect the guards regularly to confirm they are in working order.

Isolate the machine before maintenance or repair to ensure that workers who are working on the machine are kept safe.

Train workers on the safe operation of the machine and the importance of machine guarding.

Wear the correct Personal Protective Equipment for the job.

Preventing death from plant roll over

Check the ground conditions and terrain are suitable before operating the mobile plant.

Ensure the use of safety features such as roll over protective devices, seatbelts and helmets.

Ensure workers have been trained and are experienced in the operation of the plant.

Operate the mobile plant as per manufacturers recommendation.

Maintain the mobile plant as per manufacturers recommendation.

Wear the correct Personal Protective Equipment for the mobile plant and ensure that fixed protective equipment (rollover protection) is suitable and fitted.
