



NSW QUAD BIKE SAFETY REBATE AND TRAINING PACKAGE

SAFEWORK NSW

ELIGIBLE SAFETY SOLUTIONS

The package gives eligible applicants access to:

- Up to \$2,000 for the purchase of an agricultural side by side vehicle (SSV).
- Up to \$600 for the purchase of an approved operator protective device.
- Up to \$500 for the purchase of one eligible drone.
- Up to \$90 for the purchase of each helmet compliant with appropriate standards.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

If you meet the criteria below you are eligible to access the rebate and training package. Farmers can apply for two rebates totalling up to \$2,000 and workers can apply for a helmet rebate worth \$90.

QUAD BIKE AND SIDE BY SIDE SAFETY TRAINING

Free training places are available to eligible participants to complete Unit of Competency (UOC):

- AHCMOM217 - Operate Quad Bikes. Participants also receive a compliant helmet.
- AHCMOM216 - Operate Side by Side Utility Vehicles.

FOUR EASY STEPS TO CLAIM A REBATE

STEP ONE: Complete an eligible interaction by talking to us at a safety event, requesting a free safety advisory visit or participating in our online webinar.



STEP TWO: Purchase an eligible safety solution and obtain a paid tax invoice.



STEP THREE: Complete the application form, including acknowledging the full terms and conditions.



STEP FOUR: Attach your paid tax invoices and other required documentation - business owners can claim two rebates, totalling up to \$2,000, for eligible safety solutions while their workers can access up to \$90 in rebate solutions. Terms and conditions apply.
