This form is used to apply for a fireworks (single use) licence.

Only individuals who are 18 years of age or above can apply.

Only Chinese string, ground display and theatrical/indoor fireworks will be endorsed on a fireworks (single use) licence.

One application is valid for a single occasion (or event) of up to three consecutive days or extended displays. Extended display is a display that is more than three consecutive days and limited to three months for an organised public display or 12 months for a theatrical display and made by the same applicant, and the display is at the same location.

For information about completing this form refer to the *Guide for fireworks (single use) licence applicants* (catalogue no. SW08140).

Note: Do not send original documents to SafeWork NSW. Retain original documents as they are your records and must be produced on request to authorised officers of SafeWork NSW, Police and other authorised persons.

All applications **must** provide a certified copy of a photo evidence of identity as specified on page 6 of this form, as well as your interstate explosives licence (if applicable).

The JP must provide, beneath the certification, their signature, the date on which the certification was made, their JP registration number and the state in which they are registered.
