

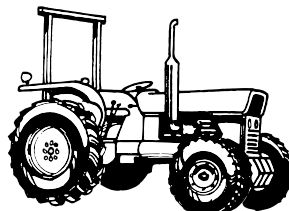
Safety around **your tractor**



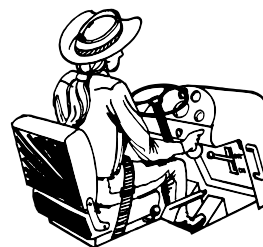
Make sure you know your way around the tractor. Read and follow the manufacturer's operating instructions.



When changing tyres always use a tyre safety cage or other approved guard.



All tractors between 560 and 15,000 kgs must be fitted with an approved Roll Over Protective Structure (ROPS).



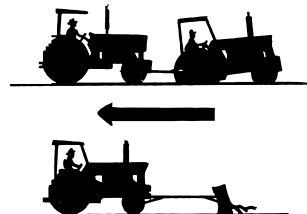
Adjust the seat so that all controls are in reach. Seat belts should be worn with tractors fitted with ROPS or enclosed cabin.



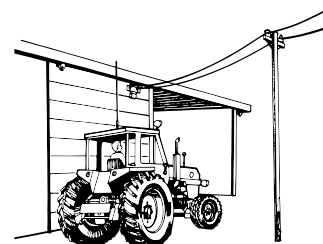
Always back up steep slopes. Never traverse across steep slopes.



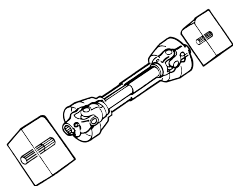
Never drive close to the edge of embankments, trenches or ditches.



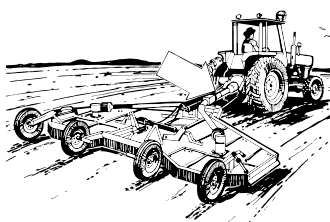
Always recover bogged vehicles as per the manufacturer's instructions.



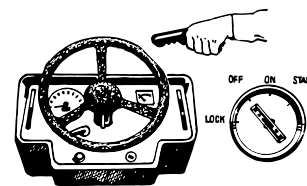
Always stay well clear of overhead powerlines.



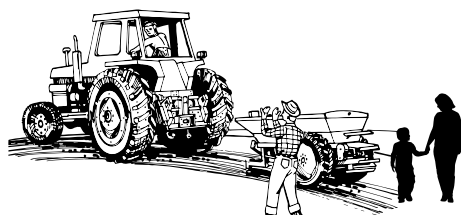
Power take-off (PTO) shafts must be fully guarded, eg with a PTO guard.



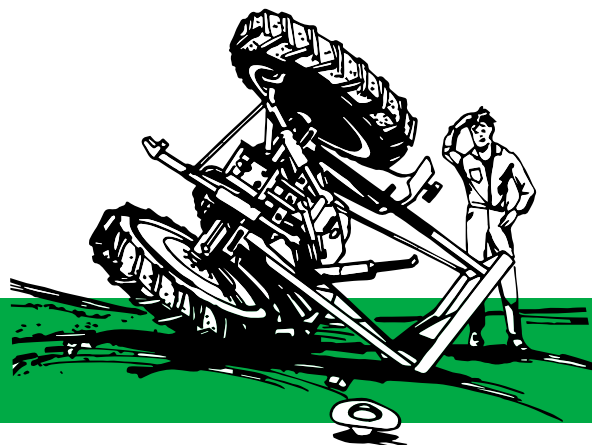
Always apply the park brake when not in the driver's seat.



Always remove keys when the tractor is not in use.



Always stay alert and **LOOK OUT** for people.
