Customisable discussion dice


Instructions

1. Print the template.
2. Cut along the exterior lines.
3. Use the dotted lines to write down your workplace specific SafeTea event talking points.
4. Fold along the interior lines to shape the dice.
5. Glue the tabs to hold the dice together.
6. Roll the dice to see where where your safety conversation lands.
7. Note the key points from your discussion, including any actions that need to be taken.

Need help thinking of talking points?

Consider:

- the objective of your SafeTea or SafeToolbox chat. For example, is it to educate workers, identify WHS hazards or learn more about others' safety experiences in the workplace?
- the safety topics that are most relevant to your workplace. Explore our 'safety by topic' webpage for inspiration.
- how you engage your team in WHS discussions. For example, you could ask workers to share their experience managing WHS risks or seek their collaboration on problem-solving a particular WHS issue at your workplace.
